No; Swallowtail F key touch

No; Two-piece saddle on F key flap and touch

No; Two-hole boot joint system

No; Military bell

No; Bell flare

No; Bell crown

No; Bell chamber

No; Tone hole on bell

Yes; Platform on long joint

Dated; Yes; 1822

Notes; 1. Top of wing rotted off

2. No saddles, but Simiot system as axle for keys

3. Dated 1822 on boot stamp

Standing Height; Bell, long joint, boot 126.3 cm

Wing and boot; could not meas.
