Ab tone hole [on small side] 5.0mm dia.
325 mm from boot socket

Undercutting on long joint Yes, a great deal in long joint,
especially on low C tone hole

Boot joint small socket depth brass insert, cannot meas.
Boot joint large socket depth 47.5mm

Cronin Meas. 329mm

Wing thickness across E [II] tone hole 40.7mm

Maximum thickness of boot at C [IV] tone hole 49.8mm
